- **Careers:** Non-profit and community organizations, youth organizations, international environments

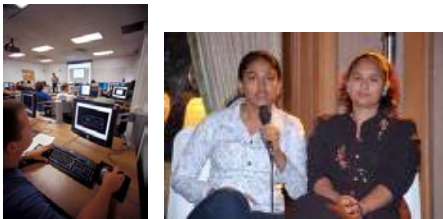


## Agricultural Communications Concentration
